Dear colleagues,

The Baltic and North Atlantic Pottery Research Group (BNPG) is a group of archaeologists, historians, art historians and such alike with a passion for medieval and post-medieval pottery produced and traded within Northern Europe. It arose in 2016 with the aim of bringing together specialists from different regions to meet and exchange knowledge.

Following the very successful first two meetings in Stockholm 2016 and in Tallinn 2018, we decided to meet again in two years in Germany. In Tallinn altogether 43 persons from 11 different countries met with different papers and sharing information and had a look on pottery.

Hereby we announce that the third meeting will take place in **Stralsund on 2-3 April 2020**. As last time, we decided that we will not need a more specific topic to address, so all contributions from people dealing with pottery from the Nordic region that would fit into medieval and later periods are welcomed.

The venue of our meeting is kindly provided by the Stralsund Museum and the meeting will take place at the Cityhall in the centre of Stralsund. Stralsund got the city status in 1234 and was one of the prosperous members of the Hanseatic League. Today the old town with its rich heritage is honored as a Unesco World Heritage.

We encourage everybody interested in the topic to send their **abstract** of no more than 250 words by **17.11.2019 to bnpg@bnpg.eu** and for registration of **participation** by **15.01.2020** to the same address.
